Name	Grade Levels	Description	Cost
Book Report	2+	Students report on the elements of a story they have read (including setting, characters, problem, solution, and their view). Saves in PDF.	
Poetry Magnets	3+	Arrange magnets to share a poem, your thoughts, or create sentences. Saves as a picture.	
Note Taker	K+	Have students use the microphone option in Suri to tell their story and have it typed. Older grades can then use it as an opportunity to edit their work.	Free
Grammar Jammers	1+	Students click on a topic and listen to the song associated with the topic and then complete practice problems	Free
Phonics Awareness	K+	Students listen to the sounds in a word and then move the bug to the correct word. It offers segmenting, blending, vowel sounds and a check yourself feature	Free
Play Sight Words grades 1&2	1+	Students can change the difficulty level and practice listening and locating sight words	Free
